

Covenant of Conduct for Seaside United Methodist Youth

1. Act responsibly and with consideration of others.
2. Respect the property and privacy of others.
3. Participate in the full program of the event and to abide by the entire schedule for the event.
4. Wear shoes for my own protection.
5. Wear appropriate & MODEST clothing. This means keeping in mind that you will be representing SUMC at all events. A) Would it meet my school dress code? B) No spaghetti straps/halter tops/backless or strapless dresses or tops. NO daisy dukes. Shorts or skirts/skorts must be fingertip length. C) Keep the “UNDER” IN UNDERWEAR – UNDERWEAR TO BE KEPT UNDER CLOTHING. D) Wear a belt. Pants must stay above the hips-no sagging. E) No one should be showing any of the 5 B’s: Breasts, Belly, Butt, Boxers/Briefs.
6. There will be no use of alcoholic beverages or drugs.
7. There will be no use of profanity, vulgar & derogatory language.
8. There will be no inappropriate forms of PDA (public displays of affection).
9. Whenever we are away from SUMC respect the living quarters of the opposite sex by not entering their room at any time.
10. Remain at the event site unless securing permission from chaperones first.
11. No smoking at youth events.
12. Be quiet enough after dorm groups so as not to bother others who may be ready to sleep. Do not leave the dorm after dorm groups. Also refrain from making noise in halls or from windows.
13. Give proper care of all host property. You will be held responsible for repair or replacement. Leave facilities in better condition than found.
14. NO cell phones or ANY electronic devices during programs and scheduled activities or they will be taken away by staff.
15. Abide by the indicated arrival times for events
16. Youth must participate in UMYF meetings on a regular basis in order to attend off premises activities.
17. Must participate in fundraisers as scheduled. If you signed up to help, please be there.
